The program targets individuals with different requirements based on their age. It caters to the needs of senior citizens, retirees, and the aged looking for leisure activities, specific support, and social interactions that are available in this organization. The services include social events, wellness and health support, meal services, exercise courses, and other supports such as transport, healthcare, and social welfare benefits.

had high school degrees. Although Indiana tries to bridge the education gap between the US and itself, it widens as people age (Schleyer et al., 2021).

Other SDOHs include geographical location, where people in urban centers are more likely to receive quality care compared to those in rural areas. People in rural regions record higher rates of poor health (Indiana State, 2021).

The economic status of the population is the third determinant. The quality of life is dependent on the financial status of an individual. Older people from poor backgrounds have experienced challenges accessing quality care in Indiana.
